

The EDDS requirements have a deadline of November 27, 2023. However, the FDA has granted a stabilization period of one year for these elements.

The EDDS requirements, in a nutshell, require all trading partners to have the ability to receive, review, and maintain transaction data in an electronic and interoperable format enabling tracking down to the individual package level.

Additionally, Pharmacies must continue to comply with the current DSCSA requirements, including:

- **Authorized Trading Partners**
- **Product Identifier**
- **Product Tracing**
- Verification

These existing requirements make up the vast majority of the DSCSA requirements.
