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Company Background

Fatigue Science, based in Honolulu, Hawaii, is supported by Archinoetics, LLC, a leading multi-disciplinary engineering and scientific research and development firm. The ReadiBand™ is based on research originally sponsored by the U.S. Department of Defense. It has previously been used by industrial and government organizations to reduce fatigue-related accidents in safety-sensitive jobs. Sleep impacts cognitive functions and reaction times, thus the ReadiBand™ is also used today by Olympic and professional athletes to maximize performance. It became available to consumers in select markets in early 2011 exclusively through partnerships with pharmacies.

Product Overview:

Average time to breakeven on initial costs is 6 weeks.

The ReadiBand™ offers the market's only fully integrated scientifically validated system for sleep quality and quantity assessment including cognitive ratings for each day. It allows consumers to get a scientifically validated sleep analysis from their local pharmacy without the hassle and expense associated with undergoing a full clinical assessment at an overnight sleep center.

The ReadiBand[™] is a wrist watch and measures the quantity and quality of sleep. Customers pick up the ReadiBand™ at a pharmacy and obtain instructions to wear it 24-hours a day for seven days. They return to the store, where the ReadiBand[™] data are analyzed by the company's proprietary software, which produces a personalized report of sleep patterns and their predicted impact on mental effectiveness, reaction times, and performance.

Upon return to the store, the customer receives counseling in understanding the findings and advice from the pharmacist regarding possible solutions. This can and does include OTC products, sleep aid products and referrals to their doctor for a possible Rx as well as suggested lifestyle modifications based on the results of their Sleep Report.

After taking steps to improve their sleep, customers are encouraged to perform a follow-up test to measure improvement. They can compare their first Sleep Report to the second for a "before and after" look at their sleep.

This cycle of four store visits offers repeat opportunities for related product sales of sleep aids, OTC products, or other items, as well as sales of unrelated products.
